

General Awkward Questions

- What is the projected electrical capacity of the hub? In other words how much electricity does it expect to transmit?
- You must have some projected targets of the amount of electricity that the wind farms will generate?
- What is the capacity of the two wind farms that are in place now?
- What happens to the electricity that they generate now?
- What happens when the wind turbines are not generating any electricity at all?
- A recent study, entitled Analysis of UK Wind Generation states that in 2010 the average output of wind was 21.1 per cent of metered capacity. Furthermore, there were 124 separate occasions from November 2008 to December 2010 when total generation from wind farms metered by the National Grid was less than 1.25 per cent of nominal capacity. That is nationwide – what happens when it falls to zero. No matter how many turbines are built it will fall to zero whenever there is no wind and whenever the wind is too strong. Do you simply close down?
